

USGA RULES APPLY

- Penalty Areas are marked by red stakes or red lines.
- Ground Under Repair is designated by white lines.
- Out of Bounds is marked by white stakes, inside edges of roads or property boundary fences. On hole 18 the greenside out of bounds is defined by a white line. If you believe your ball is out of bounds or lost please play a provisional ball or dropping as stated below.
- Relief from all Tee and Green Coquina on holes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 10, 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18.
- Relief when you pass the blue stakes on holes 5 & 6.
- Relief around tee and green, but not the fairway coquina (through the green): 9, 12.

LOCAL RULES

- Drop Areas are located on holes #8 & #9.
- Embedded Ball Rule in effect through the Green.
- If there is doubt whether a ball is in or is lost in the penalty area (On Hole 7, 14, & 16) the player may play another ball provisionally under any of the applicable options in Rule 26-1. If the original ball is found outside the penalty area, the player must continue play with it. If the original ball is found in the penalty area, the player may either play the original ball as it lies or continue with the ball played provisionally under Rule 26-1. If the original ball is not found or identified within the three-minute search period, the player must continue with the ball played provisionally.
- If a ball lies off the putting green, but not in a penalty area, and an immovable obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief.
- If the ball is found in or if it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found in a No Play Zone defined as a penalty area, the player must under penalty of one stroke, proceed under rule 26-1. These areas are defined as a red stake with a green top and are not to be entered or played out of.
- If your ball hits the power lines on #8 you must replay the shot with NO penalty.
- If your ball is out of bounds or lost, golfers have the option to drop the ball in the vicinity of where the ball is lost or out of bounds (including the nearest fairway area), under a two-stroke penalty.
- If a player's ball is in the general area (tee to green) and there is interference from exposed tree roots that are in a part of the general area (not out of bounds) **AND your ball is within 4 club lengths, measuring from the fairway to where your ball lies**, the tree roots will then be treated as ground under repair. The player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b.
